

Our Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy governs the manner in which Catch Consulting uses, maintains and discloses information collected via our website from our customers and users of our Services.

1. Privacy

Catch Consulting takes its responsibilities towards privacy seriously and are committed to doing everything in our power to ensure that your right to privacy is maintained and protected.

2. Information We Collect

Catch Consulting may request or collect personal information from online users in a variety of ways, predominantly through online contact or sign up forms. We collect and process the above data only where it is strictly necessary to do so.

The information we collect is personal information that identifies you personally, such as:

- First and last name
- Company name
- Email address
- Phone number

Catch Consulting may also collect information about how users access our website or online systems using a tracking ID unique to each user through the use of cookies or other similar means.

3. Information Storage

Your personal information may be transferred to and stored at our office and associated data centers. By accepting our Terms & Conditions you are explicitly consenting to this transfer and storage taking place. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your personal information is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

4. Cookies

A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's computer tied to information about the user. We may use both session ID cookies and persistent cookies. For session ID cookies, once you close your browser or log out, the cookie terminates and is erased. A persistent cookie is a small text file stored on your computer's hard drive for an extended period of time.

Your browser's help file contains information and instructions for removing persistent cookies. Session ID cookies may be used by Catch Consulting to track user preferences while the user is using our website or systems. They also help to minimise load times and save on server processing. Persistent cookies may be used by Catch Consulting to store whether, for example, you want your password remembered or not, and other information. Cookies used on our websites do not contain personally identifiable information.

5. Information Usage

Catch Consulting may use the personally identifiable information collected by Catch Consulting to contact clients regarding products and services offered by Catch Consulting.

We may also use this information for research purposes regarding the effectiveness of our services and marketing and sales efforts. Catch Consulting will not in any way share this information with a third party either for free or by selling it, unless you specifically authorise such disclosures.

7. Disclosure of Information

Catch Consulting may also disclose aggregate, anonymous, data based on information collected from Users to investors and potential partners. In such cases, statistical information only will be disclosed and personally identifiable data will be kept strictly confidential. In case Catch Consulting is sold, the information collected from users may be transferred to the new owners.

Catch Consulting may from time to time engage third parties, including its own subsidiaries and affiliated companies, to preserve, analyse or otherwise store or manipulate data received by Catch Consulting from its customers. In all such cases, such third party service providers will be required to treat all such data with the same degree of care as Catch Consulting and they will be prohibited from disclosing such data to any other person or party, except as otherwise provided for in this Privacy Policy.

8. Legal Disclaimer

Though we make every effort to preserve your privacy, we may need to disclose personal information when required by law, if we have a good-faith belief that such action is necessary and required to comply with a current judicial proceeding, a court order or legal process served on Catch Consulting.

Catch Consulting website/s contain links to other sites. Please be aware that Catch Consulting is not responsible for the privacy practices of such other sites. We encourage you to read the privacy statements of each and every web site that collects personally identifiable information. The Catch Consulting Privacy Policy as described herein applies solely to information collected by Catch Consulting.

10. Maintenance of Information

The information provided to Catch Consulting is retained for only as long as reasonably necessary to fulfil the purposes of our collection and may be stored on one or more databases directly or indirectly maintained by Catch Consulting. Catch Consulting employs industry standard security measures to protect the confidentiality of the information.

While we cannot guarantee that loss, misuse or alteration to data will not occur; we make every effort to prevent such occurrences. Any other particularly sensitive information is encrypted prior to transmission by you to Catch Consulting.

Should there be any breach, Catch Consulting will notify and report this breach to the relevant supervisory authority within 72 hours.

11. Your Data Protection Rights Under The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

As a Data Subject, you have the following data protection rights:

- If you wish to access, correct, update, or request deletion of your personal information, you can do so at any time by emailing steph.townsend@catchconsulting.co.nz.
- In addition, you can object to the processing of your personal information, ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information, or request portability of your personal information. Again, you can exercise these rights by emailing steph.townsend@catchconsulting.co.nz.
- You have the right to opt-out of marketing communications we send you at any time. You can exercise this right by clicking on the "unsubscribe" link in the marketing emails we send you. To opt-out of other forms of marketing, please contact us by emailing steph.townsend@catchconsulting.co.nz.
- Similarly, if we have collected and process your personal information with your consent, then you can withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawing your consent will not affect the lawfulness of any processing we conducted prior to your withdrawal, nor will it affect the processing of your personal information conducted in reliance on lawful processing grounds other than consent.
- You have the right to complain to a data protection authority about our collection and use of your personal information. For more information, please contact your local data protection authority.
